Outdoor ground conditions: The ground in this area is a mix of paving stones and brick cobble. There are areas which are sectioned off with benches. There is an area which is sectioned off with planters. The King William Street outdoor area is wheelchair accessible. There are some parts of the sectioned off areas which are also accessible via a short set of steps.

Environmental Factors

- Sound: A film will be shown in this space on Saturday 5th July. This film will have amplified sound. On Sunday 6th July, a performance will take place in this space. This performance will not have amplified sound
- Capacity: Each activity in this space will have limited capacity and some require booking in advance. There may be a short wait / queue if an activity is at full capacity

King William Street entrance

The Mall Physical Access:

- Location: Indoor venue
- Building Type: Multi-storey with lift access across all floors
- Toilets: Standard gendered toilet facilities with multiple cubicles are available on the first floor. These are accessible either via a spiral staircase with handrail or via lift access. Accessible toilet facilities are available on the ground floor and Blackburn Market has a Changing Places facilities. These bathroom facilities have more space and equipment including a height adjustable changing bench and hoist

Environmental Factors:

- Seating: Bench seating is available across The Mall. Blackburn Market also has lots of seating in the food vendor area
- Sound: Multiple activities will happen within the space at one time with varying noise levels throughout the day
- Capacity: Each festival activity in this space will have limited capacity and some require booking in advance. There may be a short wait / queue if an activity is at full capacity

Shop Three - The Mall (Girls with Drills)

The Mall King William Street entrance is the closest to this venue. This venue is accessible from any entrance at The Mall.

Physical Access:

- Location: Indoor venue
- Entrance: This venue has level access with an open doorway. This entrance is wheelchair accessible. This venue is on one level.
- Toilets: Multiple toilet facilities available inside The Mall Blackburn. See 'The Mall' accessibility information on page 24.

- Seating: No seating provided other than for participants of a workshop
- Sound: Girls with Drills will be running two activities in this venue where you can learn DIY skills. Expect noises from tools being used in this venue such as drilling and hammering. Ear Defenders will be available in this venue to use for these workshops
- Capacity: In the morning, Girls with Drills will run a bookable stool making workshop. You will only be able to access this workshop if you have booked a place in advance. From 13:30pm on Saturday and Sunday Girls with Drills will run a drop-in Stud Wall - DIY Skills workshop. This activity has limited capacity. There may be a short wait / queue if an activity is at full capacity
